

Power Cart Policy



To ensure the safety of all members and guests, and to minimize liability concerns, the following policy regarding the rental and operation of power carts will take effect as of 2024.

Age and Licensing Requirements:

- The minimum age to rent and operate a power cart is **18 years old**. Valid identification is required for age verification.
- Cart attendants are also subject to this policy unless they are 18 years or older.

Safety Rules:

- Obey all traffic signs and remain on designated cart paths at all times.
- Drive at a safe speed and exercise caution, particularly in areas with limited visibility, or steep declines.
- Follow all instructions related to the safe operation of carts provided by course staff.

Usage Guidelines:

- Carts are prohibited from driving on greens, tee boxes, or other restricted areas as indicated by signage.
- A maximum of **two passengers** are allowed per cart.
- Park carts in designated areas when not in use, ensuring they are properly secured.

Weather and Course Conditions:

- Cart usage may be restricted during adverse weather conditions or when the course is wet or muddy. Always follow posted signs or instructions from course staff regarding cart restrictions.

Liability and Damages:

- Users are responsible for any damage caused to the cart or the course during their use.
- Report any incidents immediately to the Golf Shop. Users may be financially liable for any damages incurred.

Compliance and Enforcement:

- Failure to comply with this policy may result in suspension of cart privileges or other disciplinary actions.
